

Poppyscotland Volunteer Awards

About the awards

People who currently volunteer for Poppyscotland are eligible for awards.

Our volunteers are the lifeblood of Poppyscotland. Their support collecting for the Scottish Poppy Appeal means we can make a life-changing difference to our Armed Forces community.

Corporate organisations, schools and other groups that show consistent support for Poppyscotland over a number of years will also be able to receive a Certificate of Appreciation.

How to order

The awards proposer, who is normally a Scottish Poppy Appeal Area Organiser, should complete the details of the individual or group being nominated for an award on the form overleaf. Due to the volume of requests received we only process volunteer awards once a year. Forms should be returned by the 25 July and awards will be sent out in September of that year directly to volunteers.

Please do not apply for more than one award per person at a time. Volunteers will not automatically receive a badge when they reach their next milestone, a new nomination for each badge must be made. Area Organisers can nominate themselves for an award.

The awards

The criteria for qualifying awards are:

After 5 years of volunteering

5 years poppy pin badge and commemorative certificate.

After 10 years of volunteering

10 years poppy pin badge and commemorative certificate.

After 15 years of volunteering

15 years poppy pin badge and commemorative certificate.

After 20 years of volunteering

20 years poppy pin badge and commemorative certificate.

After 25 years of volunteering

Solid silver poppy pin badge and 25 years pin badge to be worn below the silver poppy pin and a commemorative certificate.

After 30 years of volunteering

30 years pin badge to be worn below the silver poppy pin and commemorative certificate.

After 40 years of volunteering

40 years pin badge to be worn below the silver poppy pin and commemorative certificate.

After 50 years of volunteering

Solid silver gold plated poppy pin badge and 50 years pin badge to be worn below the gold poppy pin and commemorative certificate.
